This is what we can offer - would it be useful to you?

- Help if you have a sensory impairment, if you are a client of the Mental Health Services, if you have a mobility impairment, or have emotional/ behavioural needs
- Enlarged computer screens, handouts and keyboards
- Handouts in different fonts and on coloured paper
- A communicator and a hearing amplifier if you have a hearing impairment
- A scribe if you have dyslexia or dyscalculia difficulties

Please talk to your Personal Tutor or pop into Learner Services.

This is what you can expect us to do:

- We can provide assistance for when you are in the classroom
- We can provide help for you when you need to sit your exams such as a scribe, a room to yourself or extra time – but you must come and talk to us about this when you start your course or as soon as possible once you're on your course. You might also have to provide some form of evidence that you need these arrangements making for you.
- We can provide support and guidance
