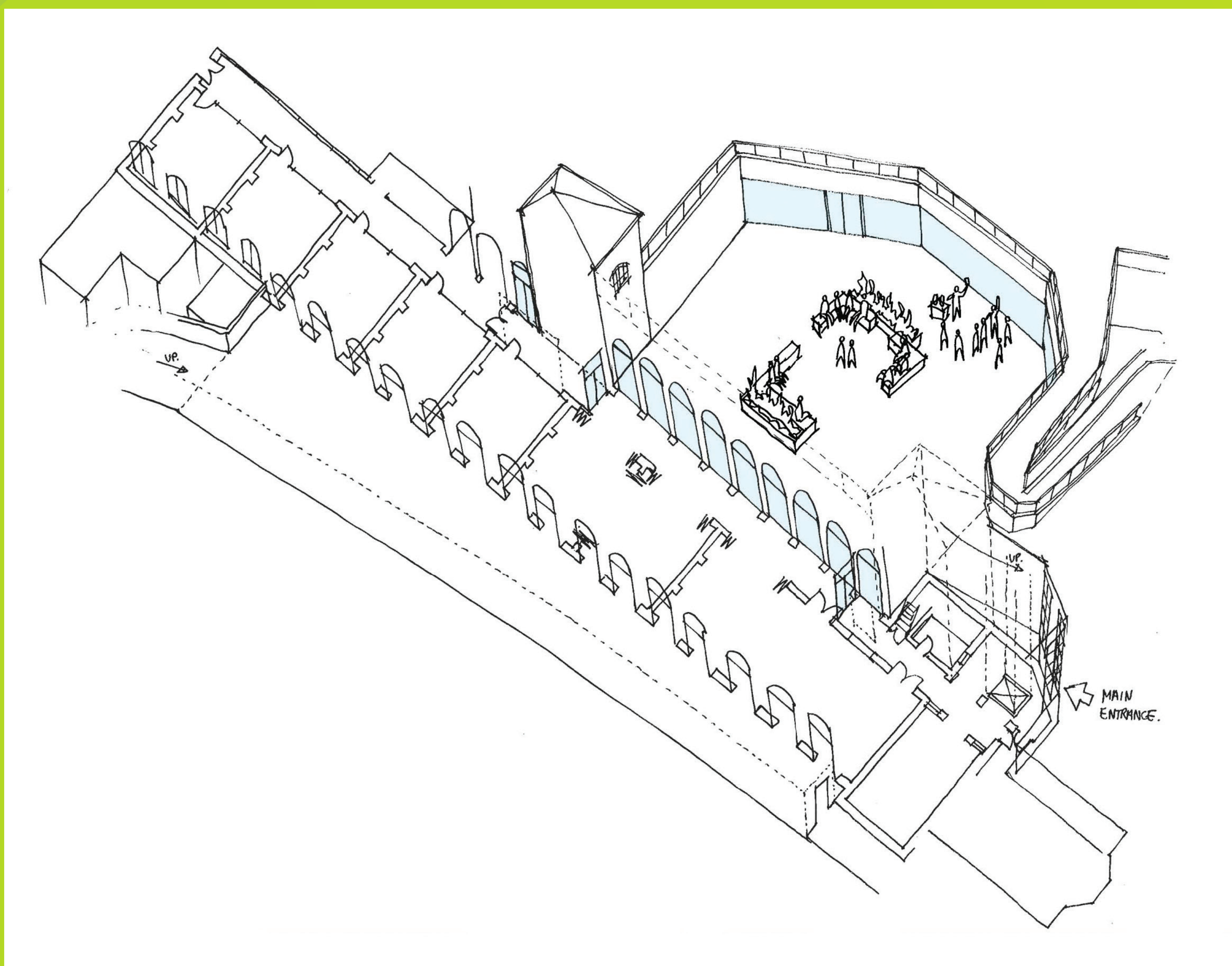


GIVING A NEW LOOK TO NORTH BLOCK 4

COURTYARD AS EXTENDED LEARNING SPACE

The courtyard has the potential to act as an extension of the classroom space. The space can be broken into smaller pockets of learning space using either fixed hard landscaping to provide seating areas or by moveable temporary interventions. Hard landscaping can be interspersed with an attractive soft landscaping scheme to aid acoustics and screening, as well as providing additional social space outside of teaching time.



COURTYARD AS EXHIBITION SPACE

The courtyard could be used to create an effective link between North Block 4 and North Block 3 by creating lively and inspiring space for the display of students work. The sheltered South facing courtyard provides a perfect setting for a sculpture garden, which can act as an extension of the buildings through the installation of sliding or folding doors to create a seamless flow between the spaces in summer months.
