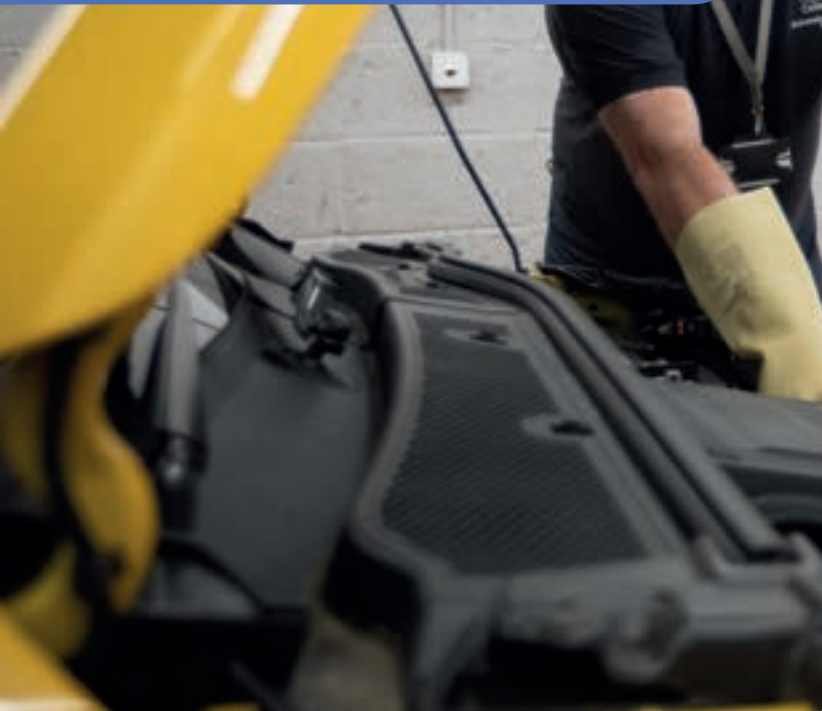

Hazards surrounding electric/hybrid vehicles
- Reducing the risks to yourself and others when working on electric/hybrid vehicles
- Making a electric/hybrid vehicle high energy system "safe" to work on  
Reinstating a electric/hybrid vehicle high energy system
